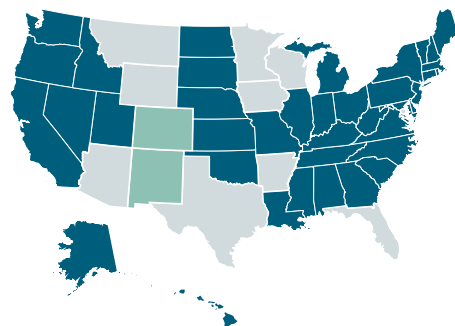




**Powdered alcohol is exactly what it sounds like: alcohol in powder form.
